SERVICE PATHWAY FOR CARERS

Registration/re-registration: telephone support, information, advice, signposting

Support work (within 3 days critical need, 7 - 10 days substantial)

Carers Assessments (on behalf of Wiltshire Council) - contact within 3 days for critical referrals

Carers Emergency Card and Wiltshire Passport (access to beneficial rates in shops and businesses in Wiltshire)

Support groups: structured groups including creative activities and specialist mental health and parent carer support groups, run on an eight-week cycle in five locations across the county

Prescription breaks for carers (from GP)

Mental health carers hospital drop-in monthly at Green Lane, Devizes (similar planned for Fountain Way, Salisbury)

Carers training programme - free to all carers, county-wide in a variety of formats including online learning

Subsidised reconditioned laptops for carers: £59.50 with open source software (subject to availability)

Carers Breaks: complementary therapies, days out, events, book group, walking group, gardening group, pampering (as advertised in our newsletter and online) Carers clinics in GP surgeries across county - contact CSW or own GP surgery for dates

Time out grant (£30) on request

Monthly volunteer-led cafes county-wide

Counselling (including CBT)

Time to talk and befriending services: county-wide volunteer-led service

Carer involvement: carers are able to help influence development of services for carers in Wiltshire
