The training courses in this booklet are part of a multi-agency Carer Training Network which Carer Support Wiltshire has been asked to lead on by Wiltshire Council and NHS Wiltshire CCG. It aims to promote and deliver training to unpaid carers living in Wiltshire, as well as to raise carer awareness amongst professionals.
